Sun Valley, Idaho

February 21 – 28, 2015 Sun Valley has a storied history of the rich and famous visiting and enjoying this destination resort. In the fall of 1936, the first chairlifts in the world were installed on Dollar and Procter Mountains. Ski bum turned filmmaker, Warren Miller, began making ski movies in this resort between 1946 and 1949. Two mountains – Dollar and Bald – offer an extended range of skiing activities. Bald Mountain summits at 9,150 feet, with a vertical drop of 3,400 feet. The slope ratings are 36% easiest, 42% more difficult, and 22% most difficult. The treeless Dollar Mountain at 6,638 feet has a moderate vertical drop of 628 feet, and is ideal for novice and lower intermediate skiers. Yearly snowfall averages in excess of 200 inches, and if that is not enough, widespread snowmaking is a backup. In addition to downhill skiing, Sun Valley offers cross country skiing, ice skating, art galleries, theater, and nightlife. A popular activity is a dinner sleigh ride to a log cabin in the woods.

Thirty Vagabonds will enjoy a first for our Club: We are flying out of Milwaukee, with a stop in Denver, direct to the Sun Valley airport, about 25 miles from the ski area. We are eliminating the three hour bus ride from Boise to Sun Valley and/or the hour and a half bus ride from Milwaukee to O'Hare. Our home for the week is the Snowcreek Condos, deluxe 2 bedroom/2 bath & 3 bedroom/3 bath units. Skiers can walk to the terrain park and beginner slopes of Dollar Mountain. The nearby shuttle offers guests free rides to the more advanced terrain of Bald Mountain or to downtown Ketchum.

Park City, Utah

March 14 – 21, 2015 During the 2002 Olympic games, Park City hosted several skiing and snowboarding venues. The summit is 10,000 feet with a vertical drop of 3,100 feet. There are 8 mountain peaks, with a total skiable area of 3,000 acres, and an annual snowfall of 365 inches. Total trails number 116, broken down as follows: Beginner: 17%; Intermediate: 52%; and Expert: 31%.

Two nearby resorts are worth visiting. Deer Valley consists of 6 mountains and is noted for its prohibition of snowboarders. Canyons, the largest ski and snowmobile resort in Utah, has the advantage of honoring the Epic ski pass.



Forty Vagabonds will be spending the week at the Snow Flower Condos, a **ski in/ski out** facility. All Snow Flower Condos have fully furnished kitchens, balconies, and fireplaces.
