
Wednesday Walks

Keep Your Membership Current!

If you haven't renewed by Oct. 1, you will receive another reminder with a renewal button that you can click or tap. A screen will pop up with a "Pay Online" button. Tap or click it to advance to the PayPal payment screen. Complete your PayPal or credit card information, click or tap CONTINUE to view the second PayPal screen and click PAY.

If you choose to bypass the email option, you may renew directly from your Profile Page by clicking or tapping the "Renew to October 1, 2022" button. Complete the payment screens with your credit card information.

Join us **Feb. 25-27** for a weekend of skiing at Indianhead Mountain and Blackjack Mountain, with 15 lifts and over 400 skiable acres. A complimentary shuttle bus runs every half-hour, so you can enjoy both hills.
