ADD THE WILD APRICOT APP TO YOUR SMART PHONE

No matter where you go, you can register and pay for events, view a list of events you have registered for, access the online directory, view and edit your profile page and much more using your smart phone. You must have logged in to the online system and established a password prior to using the smart phone app. To add the app to your phone:

- Go to the app store you use (Apple app store, google play, etc.) Search for "Wild Apricot – Member" and download it.
- Open the Wild Apricot app and look at the bottom of the screen. You'll see four icons:
- Tap "Members" to see the member directory. Tap the magnifying glass to search for a specific member.

- Tap "Event List" to view the events open for registration. Tap a specific event to register for it.
- Tap "My Tickets" to view a list of events you have registered for.
- Tap "Profile" to view or update your profile.

Tips for Signing up for a Ski Trip

Tips on Maintaining your Ski Bindings

Your ski bindings maintenance plan should begin at the start of the season. Bring your bindings to a well-respected ski shop and have them checked for common defects which include broken parts and loose screws. Your bindings can be damaged during transport.

- Bindings cannot be tuned and are maintenance free. They can only be adjusted for release settings and inspected/tested.
- Keep the AFD (anti-friction device) clean and replace it immediately if it gets damaged.
- Do not attempt to wash out your bindings at the end of the season as this can remove the factory lube. Only a certified technician should work on bindings.
- Store your skis in a warm, dry place in the off-season.
