## Sunday bike rides

### Ride Etiquette and a Fun Fact

- ◆ To ride safely as a group, we aim for a speed of 10-12 mph.
- ◆ Except when passing, we ride single file on the right side of the trail.
- ◆ Pass on the left, and alert others while doing so.
- ◆ Always control your speed and slow down when approaching other trail users.
- ◆ On multi-use trails, please note the following yielding hierarchy – key point is watch out for hikers:
  - a. Cross-country skiers yield to hikers.
  - b. Horses yield to cross-country skiers then to hikers.
  - c. Bicyclists yield to horses then to cross-country skiers then to hikers.
  - d. Snowmobilers yield to bicyclists then to horses then to cross-country skiers then to hikers.
- ◆ Bicycle helmets are strongly encouraged on our rides.
- ◆ Fun Fact: The same energy that is expended walking can be used with a bicycle for a threefold increase in speed.

### Arrive by 1:30 p.m. each week unless otherwise noted.

**Sept. 1 – Whitnall Park, 12:15 p.m.** (note special start time): This ride starts at 12:30 p.m. on the Sunday of Labor Day Weekend. We will meet at Whitnall Park in Hales Corners, at the Picnic Area No. 5 parking lot. The route is a round trip between Whitnall Park to a point near the Milwaukee County Sports Complex, around 13 miles on mostly flat trails. Target completion of the bike ride is 2 p.m. Afterward, we will have a picnic at Picnic Area No. 5 in Whitnall Park. Ride Leader is **Gary Kovach**, sweep is **Connie Sandell**. Questions? **Sept. 8 – Pollworth Park in Merton:** We will meet at Pollworth Park on White Tail Run Road in Merton (please note that Google Maps may say Hartland). No state trail pass is needed. There is a porta potty at the park. We will go 19 miles round trip. The route is mostly flat and paved, with a considerable amount of shade. The trail passes some roads. Notably, two of the roads (Sussex at Main Street and at Waukesha Avenue) are busy but have crossing lights. We will turn around at Menomonee Park, which has a water-filled quarry lake and restrooms. Afterward, we will meet at Beer Snobs Ale and Eats, 122 Cottonwood Ave., Hartland. The ride leader is Jim Shelbrock, (262) 442-2028). The sweep is Joann Jacobs, (262) 751-2693.

**Sept. 15 – Petrifying Springs Park in Kenosha:** Meet at the parking lot near Shelter No. 5 at Petrifying Springs Park. Located, 5555 7th Street, Kenosha, near the University of Wisconsin-Parkside. Please be ready to ride at 1:45 p.m. This paved bike trail travels east and south through Kenosha County. We will pass the UW-Parkside and continue south through Kenosha County to 35th Street. Total ride is about 18 miles on a mostly flat pathway. Afterward, we will go to the Petrifying Springs Biergarten, which is adjacent to the park.
