#### **Sunday bike rides**

#### **Bicycle Safety and Etiquette Tips**

To ensure a safer ride for all, please note the following guidelines for the Vagabond Summer Biking Program:

- Wear a helmet to protect your head.
- Wear brightly colored clothing.
- Ride a well-maintained bicycle.
- Check brakes and tire inflation regularly.
- Use headlights and taillights at night.
- → Have 3-inch reflectors on your back fender.
- Look out for hazardous surfaces.
- ♦ Obey all traffic laws, signs, and markings.
- Never ride against traffic.
- → Ride on the right edge of the pavement.
- ♦ Ride in single file.
- Always use hand signals to let cars and pedestrians know what you are going to do.
- Be aware of road traffic.
- ◆ Avoid being "doored." Riding close to parked cars leaves cyclists vulnerable to car doors.
- ♦ Always lock your bike when it is going to be out of sight.
- ◆ Riders should notify the leader or sweep if they intend to leave the group ride before the end.

Arrive by 1:30 p.m. each week, and be ready to ride at 1:45.

**June 1 – Glacial Drumlin Trail from Waukesha to Wales and back:** Meet at the trailhead parking lot, 810 College Ave., Waukesha. Ride starts at 1:45 p.m. This trail requires a State Trail Pass. See *Life* for details on pass. A stop at LeDuc's Frozen Custard. Afterward: The Neighbors Bar & Grille at

**June 8 – Grafton to Port Washington** Meet at Veterans Memorial Park, Grafton (Parking lot on western bank of Milwaukee River, off Wisconsin Route 60). Address: 1202 13th Ave., Grafton. From Veterans Park, we will travel northeast on the Interurban Trail.

The length of the ride is 15 miles, and the trail involves some city and county roads; the surface is asphalt or on the road. We'll have light refreshment in Port Washington and return to Grafton on the same path.

Afterward meet at the Stillery, 1302 12th Ave., Grafton, which is walkable from Veterans Memorial Park.

**June 15 – Hank Aaron Trail:** We will meet in front of the Twisted Fisherman Restaurant, 1200 W. Canal St. in Milwaukee. Park on either side of the street just west of the restaurant. Watch out for "No Parking" signs if you go too far west. Do not park in the restaurant parking lot.

The trail is asphalt with some hills. The 20-mile ride will include some sidewalks, and we will be crossing some streets. After the ride, meet at the Twisted Fisherman for food and drinks. Ride Leader: **Gary Kovach**, (414) 712-3897. Sweep: Connie Sandell.

**June 22 –** No local ride scheduled. The annual Weekend Bike Trip will be June 19-22 in Minnesota.

#### June 29 - Hartland to Sussex, early start time of 10 a.m.:

Meet in Hartland Public Parking Lot behind Senor Tomas restaurant at 150 North Ave., Hartland. Look for the sign with the large, blue P for parking.

We will ride along the Bark River on the paved Ice Age Trail, low-traffic roads and the Bug Line Trail to the Corky Curtis Trail in Sussex and then return. There are a few medium hills along the 22-mile route.

Hartland is having a Hometown Parade on this day starting at 1:30. Bring chairs along if you want to watch the parade after the ride.

Senor Tomas Restaurant is now closed on Sundays. We could eat at Beer Snobs, 122 Cottonwood Ave. Because of the parade and closed streets, you would need to walk a couple of blocks to Beer Snobs.

If you do not want to stay until the parade is over, it might be best to park in the Sendik's parking lot (600 Hartbrook Drive) and ride your bike over to the lot behind Senor Tomas.
